### 4 CDC AND GCC COUNCILLOR REPORTS

#### 4.1 Cllr Julia Judd:

Report Received ahead of the meeting. Main points discussed:

- UK Shared Prosperity Fund & Rural England Prosperity Fund now open. Projects applied for must be capable of being delivered within the financial year in which funding is allocated. CDC recently ran a 'Call for Projects' which generated over 60 responses in little more than a week, so they are expecting to be oversubscribed for funds.
- Planning application for Truck Stop/HGV/Car parking on Gloucester Road Stratton was refused by CDC. Applicant to Appeal – Earliest Date 12/01/2023
- Barrow Wake: Campaign to improve area – some improvement noted
- WASTE WIZARD – website giving residents clear answers about what goes where in their recycling bins.
