2 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Minutes of Meeting 14 October 2025 were approved and signed.

4 **PUBLIC FORUM** – NO members of the public attended on this occasion.

5 CDC WARD COUNCILLOR REPORT: JULIA JUDD

Cllr Judd provided a report ahead of the meeting. Key points:

- Unitary Authority Proposals to be submitted to Govt 28 November 2025:
Consultation will open in the new year. Groups of Parishes could form Area Boards/Neighbourhood Committees to gain stronger representation – 9,000 residents would be required. Funding may not be sufficient to pay for officer to administer.
- Govt Housing Supply Target Increase – CDC currently calling for sites until 18 Dec.
- Julia and CDC CEO Jane Pollard conducted tour of Ermin Ward villages. Provided insight into effect of badly planned road closures eg Elkstone. PC reported Park Corner road closed without notice.
- CDC Forum November 10. 2 Parish Cllrs and Clerk Attended. Update to Local Plan
 - changes to Planning re Housing Supply targets imposed by Govt - doubled
 - CDC Development Strategy: Potential development locations identified;
 - Public consultation opens 14 November – 2 January. PC to encourage residents to participate – Have a say on where development takes place.


